

Surry Volleyball Outlasts Cape Fear



Sophomores Brittany Tolbert, Elizabeth Marshall, Hayley Shore, Summer Robertson, and Kara Hodges helped defeat Cape Fear in their final home regular season game.

Dobson, NC – Surry rallied from a 2-1 deficit to defeat Cape Fear, 3-2 in Region X volleyball action on Friday. The Lady Knights took game one, 25-20, however, the Sea Devils evened the match taking the second set, 25-21. Cape Fear then took a 2-1 lead in the third set, 25-20. Surry evened the match at 2-2 by capturing the fourth set in thrilling action, 25-23. The Lady Knights then finished off the Sea Devils, 15-11 in the deciding fifth set. “We had strong play from everyone,” stated Surry coach Jan Marion-Kiser. “It was a total team effort and one of our best games all year.”

Brittany Tolbert led the Surry offense with 23 kills while Summer Robertson added 13 kills. Kara Hodges dished out a game high 49 assists for the Lady Knights while Hayley Shore and Elizabeth Hawkins each notched a service ace. Hawkins recorded a game high 21 digs while Tolbert added 15 digs and Alysha Shelton chipped in with 14 digs. Jennifer Coe led Surry with eight blocks while Robertson added four blocks. “I am so proud of our sophomores for all they have meant to our program,” added Marion-Kiser. “It was an outstanding volleyball game.”

Surry (19-5, 13-3 in Region X) travels to Piedmont College on Tuesday for a 6 pm game against the Lady Conquerors. The Lady Knights wrap up the regular season on Friday traveling to Wake Tech for a tri-match against Vance-Granville and Wake Tech.
