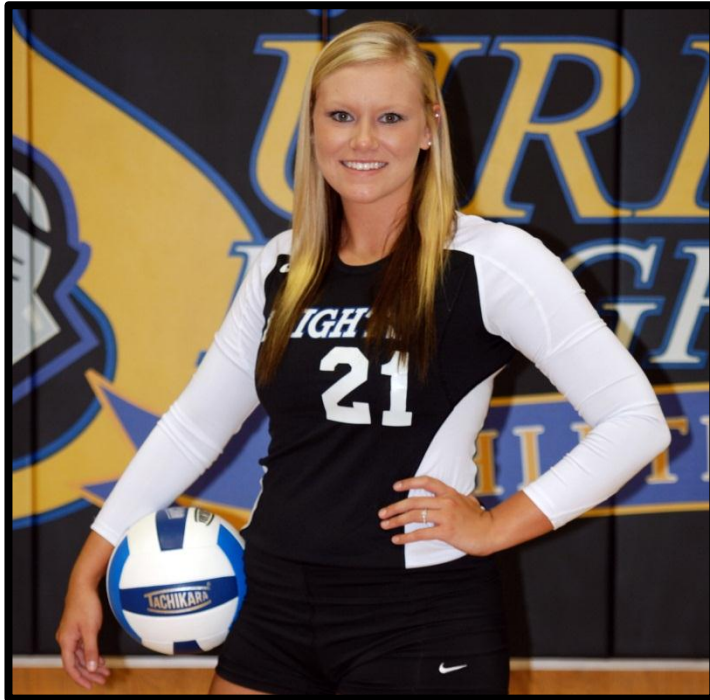


Surry Volleyball Tops Catawba-Valley



Dobson, NC – Surry defeated Catawba-Valley in three sets on Tuesday in Region X volleyball action. Surry took the first set, 25-16, behind the strong play of Kara Hodges and Emily Roberts. During the first set, Hodges (left) dished out twelve assists while Roberts connected on five kills. The Lady Knights then captured the second set in dramatic fashion, 26-24. With the game at set point for Catawba-Valley, 24-21, Surry reeled off five straight points behind the serving of Summer Robertson to take the set. The Lady Knights then finished off the Buccaneers, 25-14, in the third set behind Brittany Tolbert’s seven kills.

“We had a great effort from everyone,” stated Surry coach Jan Marion-Kiser. “I thought we really played well together and competed tonight. We did a great job of containing their hitters.”

For the Lady Knights, Tolbert finished with twelve kills while Robertson finished with nine and Roberts added eight. Hodges dished out a game high 33 assists while Robertson notched two service aces. Defensively, Roberts recorded seven digs while Tolbert added six. Robertson and libero, Alysha Shelton, each contributed five digs. Robertson also led the Knights in blocks with four while Jennifer Coe and Hodges each added two blocks.

Surry (5-0) travels to Pitt Community College on Saturday for a tri-match with the Bulldogs along with Rockingham Community College. The Lady Knights take on Rockingham at 10 am before battling Pitt at 12 pm. Surry then travels to Davidson County Community College on Monday before returning home on September 24 by hosting a tri-match with Lenoir Community College and Virginia Western College starting at 1 pm.
