

Knights Sweep Wilkes in Volleyball

Dobson, NC – Surry raced out to a 17-1 lead in the first set before finishing off the Cougars in three straight sets on Tuesday. Trailing 1-0, Kara Hodges reeled off 17 consecutive points as the Lady Knights took the first set, 25-6. Surry once again started strong in the second set leading 19-5 behind the strong serving of Elizabeth Hawkins. The Lady Knights wrapped up the set, 25-6, before capturing the match in the third set, 25-19. “We were able to serve and pass well during the match,” stated Surry coach Jan Marion-Kiser. “We were able to get everyone some valuable playing time especially with four games left this week.”

Summer Robertson paced the Surry offense with seven kills while Emily Roberts added six. Jennifer Coe and Brittany Tolbert each added three kills for the Knights.
