

Surry Knights Defeat Stanly Community College

Showers and cloudy conditions did not get the Knights Softball Team down as they swept Stanly Community College Thursday, April 2, 2009, in a conference doubleheader at Fisher River Park in Dobson, NC.

In the first of the doubleheader, Brooke Honeycutt took the mound for Surry in a shutout performance. She pitched a complete game giving up one hit and one walk for the win. Offensively, Brittany Draughn and Megan Stanley went 2 for 3, while Honeycutt, Shawn Watson and Mallorie Vogler each went 1 for 3. The Knights scored their lone run in the third inning when Brittany Draughn reached on an error by the shortstop for Stanly and a stolen base to second put Draughn in scoring position. Brooke Honeycutt followed with a double that would score Draughn and be enough for the win.

Shawn Watson's triple off Stanly's pitcher, Katie Reynolds, in the second inning would put the Knights on the board in the second game 2-0. The inning started with a lead off walk by Megan Stanley, a sacrifice bunt by Dawn Sisk to put Stanley at two followed by another walk for Hannah Bullins. With two runners on, Watson drives one over the left fielders head for two RBIs and the lead. Surry would score once more in the fifth with another lead off walk for Mallorie Vogler and a double for Brittany Draughn to score Vogler.

Watson also contributed seven innings of work on the mound for the win. With five hits allowed and only one walk Stanly was able to make a run by scoring first in the first inning and adding another in the seventh when the runner reach on an error and advance.
