

Surry Downs Lenoir in Volleyball



The Lady Knights swept Lenoir on Saturday in Region X action.

Dobson, NC – Surry defeated visiting Lenoir Community College in three straight sets on Saturday in Region X volleyball action. The Lady Knights took the first set, 25-12, behind strong serving from Kara Hodges and Summer Robertson. Hodges served three aces to give Surry a 5-1 lead over the Lancers while Robertson notched two aces to help build a 12-5 lead the Knights would not relinquish. Surry took the second set, 25-10, behind Emily Roberts. The freshman outside hitter recorded four kills in the set while also adding two digs. The Lady Knights wrapped up the match, 25-15, with Roberts and sophomore Summer Robertson pacing the offense with four kills each. “We had a very balanced attack,” stated Surry coach Jan Marion-Kiser. “It was good to get everyone some needed playing time and experience especially with five games coming up this week.”

The Lady Knights were led by Roberts with ten kills while Robertson added seven kills. Hodges led Surry with a game high 21 assists while also contributing three aces and two kills. Defensively, Brittany Tolbert recorded seven digs while teammate Alysha Shelton added six digs. Elizabeth Marshall led Surry with three blocks while Tolbert added a pair of blocks.

Surry (7-2, 5-1 in Region X) returns to action on Tuesday by hosting Wilkes at 6 pm. The Lady Knights will travel to Wytheville Community College on Thursday for a 6 pm game. Surry will wrap up the week with three games on Saturday at Catawba-Valley Community College. The Lady Knights will take on Brunswick Community at 12 pm before battling Catawba-Valley at 2 pm. Surry will conclude the event by playing Spartanburg-Methodist at 6 pm.
